Transition

You will have received our Transition and Class Structure letter on Monday with the first of our three transition sessions held on Tuesday. We hope your child enjoyed their first visit to their new year group.

DATA

Data 2018

Although still being analysed in detail and validated, I am delighted to share with you our headline data:

Year 1 Phonics – 80% of children passed (up 3% from last year and in line with National).

Year 2 Phonics – the cohort overall achieved a 90% pass mark.

Early Years – Our Good Level of Development has increased to 73% and many children gained elements of exceeding the Early Learning Goals.

Reading at Age Related Expectations is slightly above last year at 81% but those achieving at greater depth has increased again to 38%.

Writing at Age Related Expectations has decreased to 60%, which reflects our 67% boy cohort. However, greater depth is now 19% - an increase of 6%.

Maths has risen a further 5% at Age Related Expectations to 82% and is up again at greater depth to 23.6%

I would like to thank the teams for their tenacious dedication in achieving higher results for the children and for your contribution in supporting them.
