There is also the opportunity to volunteer alongside Nursing teams, either serving meals within the In-Patient Ward or being involved in creative activities as part of the Day Care service. Hospice Companion volunteers provide domestic support in the community assisting clients in their own home by completing housework, gardening or shopping.
