Following research, last week staff met to discuss the sensory overload of the Christmas period and the financial pressures on parents at this time of year. Although exciting for many...it can be a period of stress for both children and parents alike and we want to work with you to try and help where we can. Many schools are reducing the sensory overload by cancelling some traditional events. We have thought at length about this but felt some options would go down like a lead balloon!

However, we have decided to minimise the decorations in the classroom, delay the school tree until Christmas Shopping Day, cut down on Christmas making activities until the last week of term, reduce additional Christmas music and try and keep things as 'normal' and routine as possible for as long as we can.

Please note we have asked the Elves not to visit us in school, as this is also an added pressure on many families. If the Elves do visit you, please discuss with your child that this is something just for home.
