Our topics are:

All About Me and Harvest



G - Tell some stories about journeys to others.

R - Practise counting to 50. Can you count backwards?

O - Make something to tell others all about you.

W - Practise reading your reading book at least 4 times a week.

English

We will be **reading** stories about people and animals going on journeys. We will be learning to sequence the main events and to retell stories using repeated language. We will also be encouraging the children to ask questions and express their own opinions about the main events and characters in stories. When **writing**, we will be learning to compose sentences using a capital letter, full stop, noun and verb. We will be writing stories and sequencing our ideas into beginning, middle and end. We will be learning to read and spell using level 5 digraphs in **phonics**, which will come home each week. A mini book will be sent home each week for your child to read.

Maths

In **Maths**, we will be learning to count in 1s and 10s to 50, as well as represent and order numbers to 20. We will be partitioning the numbers 5,6,7 into two parts and recording these using part whole models and number sentences. We will also learn to recognise the value of coins and notes. We will begin to compare and describe lengths and heights using non-standard units of measure.

Topic

In **Science**, we will be learning about our five senses and how they help keep us stay safe as well as exploring the forces of pushing and pulling. In **History**, we will be learning about transport from the past and comparing it with transport that we use now. In **DT**, we will be designing, making and evaluating bread loaves. In **R.E**, we will be exploring the concept of being thankful. We will discuss what we are thankful for and how some Christians show they are thankful. In **Computing**, we will be learning how to use a laptop to log in and access websites. We will also be talking about how to stay safe online.
