**Your child's annual flu vaccination is now due**

This vaccination programme is in place to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

Submit your form **by 12/11/2021** to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form, telephone **0300 0030323** and the team will be happy to help.

The vaccination is free and recommended for children every year, and will be given by a quick and simple spray up the nose. The programme this year has been extended to all children and young people in Year R to Year 11.
