FOXES TRIP TO MORRISONS – TUESDAY 24th MAY 2022



As part of our preparations for our Jubilee Street Party and our topic this half term on Food, we are planning to visit Morrison's supermarket in Horndean, in the morning, on Tuesday 24th May. Once there we will have a tour of the store and purchase the items needed for our street party.

We will travel to Morrison's via the number 37 public bus, getting on near St Wilfrid's Church and getting off at Merchistoun Hall. A full risk assessment has been carried out.

All children will require a packed lunch (no chocolate or sweets). As a school we are considering our environmental impact and are therefore asking that these lunches are sent into school using a recycled brown paper bag which will be provided for you. This enables all rubbish to be thrown away. Please ensure there is a drink included. This can be accessed throughout the morning and should be in your child's named clear plastic school water bottle (metal bottles are not suitable in school). **For trips only, it is acceptable for this to be juice or squash (no fizzy drinks).**

The children will need to wear school uniform with sensible footwear and a coat appropriate for the day's weather (if necessary). Please also ensure you have applied a long lasting suncream.

We are asking you for a voluntary contribution of £5, which will include the cost of the bus, and a contribution towards the children's shopping for the Street Party. We do hope you will recognise that this is very good value and hope that you will be able to support us with meeting the cost of the trip.

Please make an online payment via your Scopay account by **Wednesday 18th May**, and **ensure you click the permission box**. If sufficient contributions are not paid, we will have to cancel the trip and return any monies paid. If you would like Hc3S to provide a packed lunch, which will consist of a sandwich of the day, biscuit and a piece of fruit, ensure you tick the "School Packed Lunch" box on scopay.
