Our topic is Journeys



G Tell some stories about journeys to others.

R Practise counting in 1s and 10s to 50 and back.

O Design and bake a new bread recipe.

W Practise reading your reading book at least 4 times a week.

English

We will be **reading** stories about people and animals going on journeys. We will be learning to sequence the main events and to retell stories using repeated language. We will also be encouraging the children to ask questions and express their own opinions about the main events and characters in stories. When **writing**, we will be learning to compose sentences using a capital letter, full stop, noun and verb. We will be writing stories and sequencing our ideas into beginning, middle and end. We will be learning to join our letters when handwriting and we will be learning to read and spell using phase 5 digraphs in **phonics**.

Maths

In **maths**, we will be learning to count in 1s and 10s to 50, as well as represent and order numbers to 20. We will be partitioning the numbers 5, 6, 7 into two parts and recording these using part whole models and number sentences. We will also be recognising the value of coins and notes, sequencing events, and comparing and describing lengths and heights using non-standard units.

Topic

In **Science**, we will be learning about our five senses and how they help keep us safe as well as exploring the forces of pushing and pulling. In **History**, we will learning about transport from the past and comparing it with transport that we use now. In **DT**, we will be designing, making and evaluating bread loaves. In **R.E**, we will be exploring the concept of 'symbols,' what symbols we use in our lives and how bread is a symbol to Christian people at Harvest time. In **Computing**, we will be learning how to use a laptop to log in and access websites. We will also be talking about how to stay safe online.
